Adobe products finally available to congregations



[Adobe](#), makers of Acrobat, Photoshop, InDesign (formerly Pagemaker), Illustrator and other software products now offers non-profit pricing to religious non-profit organizations. Adobe has long held a policy that explicitly excluded religious non-profits from its pricing discounts. Due in part to their acquisition of Macromedia which did offer discounts to religious non-profits, Adobe has changed its policy. Now, along with [Microsoft](#), Symantec and other major software vendors congregations can purchase Adobe software at a major discount.
