Risographic in Indianapolis

Riso has not had the best of reputations in the Indianapolis-area, at least this is what we've heard over the last 4 years from area congregations. The poor reputation seems to come from lack of attention by area Riso dealers. Indy Office Solutions contacted us a few weeks ago to tell us that they are now adding the Risographic line of duplicators to their service offerings.
